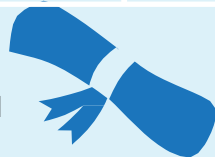
Eligibility



- High school seniors who reside in Monmouth or Ocean County and are pursuing a Bachelor's Degree.
- Applicants planning to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited four year college or university in the Fall 2019.
- Applicants/parents in financial need.
- Applicants that are members of First Atlantic

Supporting Documents

- Transcript, personal statement, and letter of recommendation are required.
- A high school transcript that contains the student's SAT, G.P.A. and an explanation of how the G.P.A. is scaled.
- Applicant must submit a one-page letter of recommendation from a teacher or school official. The letter should detail the applicant's background, achievements, leadership abilities and community involvement.
- Applicant must submit a personal statement that provides information about their community involvement, extracurricular activities, personal interests, and academic aspirations/career goals. Please include at least one paragraph about what a credit union means to you. Information about personal or financial circumstances may be added. Applicants should consider the personal statement as Statements should be two pages or less.



Awards



Four scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to qualifying High School Seniors pursuing a Bachelor's Degree at an accredited college or university.



Certification and Release

Applicant and their parent or guardian must sign the application certifying that all information provided is true and complete to the best of their knowledge. With their signature and submission of the application, applicants also grant First Atlantic the right to use their information and their likeness for the purpose of promoting and publicizing First Atlantic.

Scholarship Announcement & Payment of Award

- All applicants will be notified within one week following the application deadline date.
- Scholarship funds will be paid by check, payable to the school. Funds may be applied toward tuition, fees, and other appropriate educational expenses.

Application Requirements

- Recipient must be present to accept award at FAFCU event. Promotional pictures will be taken when awarded.
